May 31st - World no tobacco day

- 1. The theme of the day is "Bright products. Dark intentions. Unmasking the appeal."
- 2. It was a global campaign led by the World Health Organisation (WHO).
- 3. The day is observed to create awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use and to prmote current and future generations from its devastating health consequences.

Microsoft & Yotta partners to advance AI adoption across India

- 1. Microsoft and Yotta have announced a strategic partnership to support AI adoption across the country.
- 2. This aims to strengthen domestic AI capabilities and digital infrastructure.

Goa declared fully literate under ULLAS

- 1. On the momentous occasion of Goa's 39th Statehood day which is celebrated on May 30th, CM Pramod Sawant officially declared Goa as a fully literate state under the ULLAS Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram (New India Literacy Programme), a vision for Viksit Bharat.
- 2. This marks Goa as as the 2^{nd} state in India to cross 95% literacy benchmark.

India to host IATA Annual General meeting 2025

1. The International Ait Transport Association (IATA) is set to host its Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2025 and the World Air Transport Summit (WATS) in New Delhi

from June 1 to 3.

- 2. It was a historic moment to India as it hosts the prestigious event for the first time in 42 years with the last meeting was in 1983.
- 3. India's largest airline IndiGo has been designated as the host airline for the event.

India's first AI SEZ to be set up in Nava Raipur

- 1. The country's first AI focused Special Economic Zone (SEZ) is set to be developed in nava Raipur, Chattisgarh.
- 2. It was led by RackBank Datacentres Pvt. Ltd. (Indore based)
- 3. The project has been officially approved by the Ministry of Commerce and announced by the Chattisgarh government.
- 4. The investment of the project is Rs.1000 cr.

Delhi's IGIA among top 10 airport hubs

- 1. Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA) has earned a spot in the top 10 hub airports in Asia-Pacific and the Middle East as per the 2024 Air Connectivity ranking released by the Airports Council.
- 2. IGIA is the only Indian airport to make it to the list and it is operated by GMR Delhi International Airport Ltd (DIAL).

- 1. One of the most iconic atheletes, Serena Williams has been awarded the Princess of Austrias award for sports 2025.

global contribution in various fields including arts, literature and science.
