Centre notifies guidelines to boost electric car manufacturing in India

- 1. The Central govt. Notified detailed guidelines for the scheme to promote manufacturing of Electric passenger Cars in India (SPMEPCI).
- 2. The scheme is aimed at attracting global EV amkers to invest in India by offering concessional custom duty and support for both greenfield and brownfield manufacturing investments.

Retired govt NPS subscribers eligible for UPS benefits

- 1. The GoI has announced that Central govt employees who retired under the National Pension System (NPS) with atleast 10 years of qualifying service on or before March 31, 2025 can now claim additional benefits under the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS).
- 2. The deadline to apply for these enhanced benefits is June 30, 2025.
