Kamlesh Paswan inaugurates India's first Agri-drone indigeniasation hub in Chennai

- 1. Union Minister of State for Rural Employment Shri Kamlesh Paswan inaugurated the Agri-Drone Indigenization facility of Garuda Aerospace in Chennai.
- 2. Along with this the Minister also unveiled 300 Centres of Excellence (CoEs) and flagged off the DGCA approved Train the Trainer (TTT) programme.

Green Fertiliser breakthrough wins \$2M food planet prize 2025

- 1. A Swedish startup, NitroCapt has won the prestigious 2025 Food Planet Prize for its pioneering green fertiliser that uses plasma technology and renewable energy to create nitrogen fertilisers sustainably.
 - 2. The \$2 million prize was awarded by the Curt Bergfors Foundation.

PM Modi conferred with Cyprus Highest Civilian Honour



- 1. PM Modi was conferred with the Grand Cross of the Order of Makarios III which is the highest Civilian Honour of Cyprus by the President Nikos Christodoulides.
- 2. The award was given to recognize his efforts in strengthening India-Cyprus relations and promoting global co-operation.

BUSINESS NEWS

WPI inflation dips to 14-month low of 0.39% in May

- 1. Wholesale Price Inflation (WPI) declied to a 14 month flow of 0.39% in May on easing prices of food articles and fuel.
- 2. WPI based inflation was 0.85% in April. It was 2.74% in May last year.

SBI reduces interest rates by upto 50bps after RBI rate cut

- 1. SBI has reduced its lending rate by 50 basis points (bps) following RBI's rate cut making loans cheaper for both existing and new borrowers.
- 2. The repo linked lending rate (RLLR) of SBI would come down by 50 bps to 7.75%.
- 3. It has also reduced External benchmark based lending rate (EBLR) by similar bps to 8.15% from 8.65%.

Lieutenant Commander Yashasvi Solankee has been appointed as the first woman Aide-de-Camp (ADU) to the President of India.

Wimbledon 2025 sets New Prize money record at \$73 million

1. Ahead of the 2025 Wimbledon Championships, the All England Club has announced a record prize fund of 53.5 million Euro (~\$73 million).



- 2. Each men and women' singles champion will receive 3 million Euro (\$4 million) which is an 11.1% increase from last year.
- 3. The announcement revealed a **7% increase in Wimbledon's total prize money** compared to 2024.
