Bihar to host its 1st Nuclear Power Plant under India's new SMR mission

- 1. **Bihar's first nuclear power plant was announced** under the Union Government's Nuclear Energy Mission.
- 2. The plant will be based on Small Modular Reacto (SMR) technology.
- 3. It was launched in Union Budget 2025-26 with a funding of Rs. 20,000 cr.

India's 1st Quantum Computing Valley to launch in Amaravati



- 1. India's 1st Quantum Computing Valley will be launched in Amaravati.
- 2. The project was lead by Andhra's ITE&C Secretary Katamneni Bhaskar.
- 3. The initiative is called "Amaravati Quantum Valley Tech Park".
- 4. It will benefit educational institutions, pharma, healthcare, agritech and med-tech sectors.
- 5. Andhra government is colloborating with the Rata Tata Innovation Hub for youth training and upskilling.

SDG Index 2025

- 1. India for the first time secured a position among the top 100 countries in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Index.
- 2. India ranked 99th out of 167 nations with a score of 67 in the 2025 edition of the Sustainable Development Report (SDR) which was released by the UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network.
- 3. The countries which hold the top three spots are,

 - **❖** Sweden
 - **❖** Denmark
- 4. The index measures overall progress towards achieving the 17 SDGs adopted by the UN member states in 2015 with a score of 100.

EPFO raises advance withdrawl limit to Rs.5 lakh for faster fund access

Union Labour Minister Mansukh Mandaviya announced that the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) has raised the limit of auto-settlement of

advance withdrawl claims from Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh which will be disbursed within three working days.

Bharat Biotech to supply GSK's malaria vaccine to GAVI

1. Bharat Biotech International will start supplying world's first malaria vaccine RTS.S which was developed by Global Biopharma major GSk to vaccine alliance Gavi from 2026.



2. RTS.S was the first malaria vaccine recommended by the WHO in 2021.
