NATIONAL AFFAIRS

INS Tamal commissioned in Kaliningrad



1. INS Tamal (F71) was commissioned at Yantar Shipyard in Kaliningard, Russia.

2. It is a multi-role stealth guided missile frigate and the last foreign built warship inducted into the Indian Navy.

3. It is the 8th ship in the Russian origin project frigate series and the second Tushil class follow on ship.

Gujarat launches Jan Suraksha Santrupti Abhiyan

1. Gujarat CM Bhupendra Patel launched the Jan Suraksha Santrupti Abhiyan in Gandhinagar.

2. The campaign will focus on new account openings. KYC updates and digital fraud awareness.

CR Patil launches C-FLOOD

1. Union Jal Shakti Minister CR. Patil inaugurated C-FLOOD, a unified blood forecasting system.

2. The system is **developed by C-DAC Pune and Central Water Commission** (CWC) under the Ministry of Jal Shakti.

3. C-FLOOD is a web based platform that provides flood inundation maps and water level forecasts two days in advance at village level.

4. The initiative is executed under the National Supercomputing Mission (NSM) jointly by MeitY and DST.

ESIC launches SPREE 2025

1. **ESIC launched SPREE 2025** to promote registration of employers and employees.

2. SPREE 2025 - The Scheme for Promotion of Registration of Employers and Employees.



3. It is a special initiative under the ESI Act to expand social security coverage.

4. It runs from July 1st to 31st December 2025.

5. It offers a one-time opportunity for unregistered employers and workers to register.

6. Employers can register digitally via the ESIC portal, Shram Suvidha or MCA portal.

7. Registration will be valid from the employer declared date.

Virudhunagar to become global textile hub



1. A PM MITRA park will be set up in Virudhunagar,

2. The **Centre has approved Rs.1900 cr** for the park's development.

3. It is designed to be a world class hub for technical textiles and integrated manufacturing.

4. The project is expected to attract Rs.10,000 cr investment and create 1 lakh jobs by 2026.

1. PM Modi received Ghana's highest civilian award called the 'Officer of the order of the star of Ghana'.

Ravi Agarwal reappointed as CBDT Chairman



 The Cabinet Committee has approved the reappointment of Ravi Agarwal as the Chairman of the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT).
His re-appointment is on a contract basis for one year effective from July 1, 2025 to June 30,
2026 or until further orders whichever is earlier.

- 3. He is a 1988-batch IRS officer from the Income Tax Cadre.
- 4. He succeeded Nitin Gupta.
- 5. Previously he served as a member of CBDT.
