India successfully tests ERASR

1. India successfully tests the indigeneous Extended Range Anti-Submarine Rocket (ERASR) from INS Kavaratti.

2. It was developed by DRDO to get closer to the goal of self-reliance in defence under Atmanirbhar Bharat.

Adani power buys 600 MW Vidarbha unit for Rs.4,000 cr

1. Adani Power Ltd (APL) has completed the acquistion of Vidarbha Industries Power Ltd (VIPL), a 600 MW plant for Rs.4,000 cr.

2. With this acquisition, APL's total operating capacity has increased to 18,150 MW.

3. Adani power aims to reach a total power generation capacity of 30,670 MW by 2029-30.

Haryana to build Asia's biggest Jungle Safari

- 1. The Haryana govt has announced to build Asia's largest jungle safari in the Aravalli hills.
- 2. It will cover around 10,000 acres of forest land.

3. The safari will use modern technology and will be built in a grenn, eco-friendly way.

Punjab launches Mukhya Mantri Sehat Yojana

1. Punjab CM Bhagwant Mann launches Mukhya Mantri Sehat Yojana offering Rs.10 lakh free and cashless healthcare annually to all families in the state with coverage across both private and government hospitals.

This scheme aims to benefit approximately 65 lakh families, covering nearly
3 crore people across Punjab.

3. Families from all social and economic categories will be included, govt employees, pensioners, farmers, workers and businessman will also be included.

4. Every eligible family will receive a health card which allows cashless treatment at both government and private hospitals within Punjab.

5. Residents who are already enrolled under the Ayushman Bharat will also be benefited.

6. They will recive an additional Rs.5 lakh top-up cover which increases to a total of Rs.10 lakh under this initiative.
