National Broadcasting day 2025



- 1. The day is observed annually on July 23rd
- 2. Indian Broadcasting Company (IBC) was established on July 23rd, 1927.
- 3. All India Radio (AIR) was officially formed in 1936 evolving from the Indian State Broadcasting service (1930).
- 4. Broadcasts are conducted in 23 languages and 146 dialects, ensuring wide cultural reach.

India's first mining tourism project

- 1. Jharkhand is set to launch India's first mining tourism project.
- 2. Jharkhand holds nearly 40% of India's total mineral resources.
- 3. The state signed an MoU with Central Coalfields Ltd (CCL) to launch the project.

India witnesses 44% surge in IP filings

44% increase in total IP filings over five years from 4.77 lakh in 2020-21 to 6.89 lakh in 2024-25.

Indian Army inducts 1st batch of Apache helicopters

- 1. The Indian Army has received its first batch of Apache helicopters from the US.
- 2. The procurement deal was signed in 2020 between India and the US worth Rs.5,691 cr for 6 Apache helicopters.
