PM Modi launches e-VITARA and battery plant

- 1. PM Modi launched green mobility initiatives in Hansalpur, Gujarat.
- 2. He inaugurated and flagged off the 'e-VITARA', Suzuki's first Made-in India global Battery Electric Vehicle (BEV)
- 3. Hybrid battery electrode production has begun in Gujarat through a jint venture with Toshiba, Denso and Suzuki.

NHAI launches 'Project Aarohan'

- 1. National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) launched 'Project Aarohan' to support toll plaza employees' children education.
- 2. 500 students (class 11 to graduation) to receive Rs.12,000/year scholarships.
- 3. 50 top students aiming for PG/higher studies to receive Rs.50,000 scholarships.
- 4. It includes mentorship, skill-building and career guidance for holistic support.
- 5. It targeted EWS, SC/ST/OBC, minorities and first-gen learners.
