MoF introduced a one-time, one-way switch facility

- 1. Ministry of Finance introduced a one-time, one-way switch facility allowing central government employees to move from the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS) to the National Pension System (NPS).
- 2. The option will remain open until September 30, 2025.

OpenAI launched India's first Learning Accelerator in colloboration with Indian Institute of Technology IIT Madras at an event held in New Delhi.


Delhi and Oslo launch joint initiative 'DOSTI'

GoI appoints Goldman Sachs as sole banker for stake disinvestment

- 1. Government of India has appointed Goldman Sachs as the sole transaction advisor for divestment of stakes in four Public Sector banks such as IOB, CBI, UCO bank and Punjab & Sind bank.
- 2. At present, the GoI holds over 90% equity in each of these banks.
- 3. It plans to divest upto 5% of its stake in the four PSBs in two branches.
