National Nutrition Week 2025

- 1. National Nutrition Week (NNW) was observed every year from September 1 -7 to promote awareness about nutrition.
- 2. This year the theme will be "Eat right for a better life".
- 3. The idea of NNW was 1st introduced by the American Dietetic Association in 1975 with the goal of spreading awareness on the importance of nutrition and promoting dietetics as a profession.
- 4. **India began observing NNW in 1982** to address the challenges of widespread malnutrition and deficiencies in essential micronutrients.
- 5. The observance was initaited by the Food and Nutrition Board (FNB), Ministry of Women & Child Development in 1982.

- 2. "Maitree FRIENDSHIP" is the meaning of the word in Sanskrit and Thai languages symbolizing the historical, cultural and defence ties between India and Thailand.
- 3. The previous edition took place at Fort Vachiraprakan in Tak Province of Thailand.
- 4. India hosts this exercise after 5 yrs since 2019.

GoI appoints TCA Kalyani as 29th CGA



- 1. The Govt of India appointed TCA Kalyani as the 29th Controller General of Accounts (CGA) in the Dept. of Expenditure.
- 2. She is a 1991 batch Indian Civil Accounts Service (ICAS) officer.
- 3. She succeeds SS Dubey who has retired on August 31, 2025

4. Previously, she served as the Principal Chief Controller of Accounts in the Minsitry of Home Affairs.

BANKING & FINANCE

SBI, AFD signed EUR 100 million LoC

- 1. SBI has signed a Line of Credit (LoC) agreement worth EUR 100 million with France based Agence Française de Development (AFD) in Gujarat.
- 2. This colloboration is in alignment with SBI's goal of achieving a green portfolio accounting for 7.5% 10% of its domestic gross advances by 2030.

SPORTS

India tops 16th Asian Shooting Championship

- 1. The 16th Asian Shooting Championship was held in Shymkent, kazakhstan.
- 2. The competition featured 748 atheletes from 27 countries across Asia in various senior and junior levels.
- 3. The championship was organized by the Asian Shooting Confederation (ASC) in collaboration with the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) and the Kazakhstan Shooting Sport Federation.
- 4. India created history by topping the medal tally for the first time winning a total of 99 medals including 50 gold, 26 silver and 23 bronze.

Oscar Piastri wins Dutch Grand Prix 2025

- 1. Australia F1 racer Oscar Piastri secured victory at the 35th edition of the Dutch Grand Prix 2025 held at Circuit Zandvoort, Netherlands.
- 2. Max Verstappen (Netherlands) secured the 2nd position and Isack Hadjar (France) secured 3rd position.
