NATIONAL AFFAIRS

India & Israel signed bilateral investment treaty

1. The GoI has signed a Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT) with the Government of the State of Israel aimed at bolstering bilateral investments as well as

- expanding relations between the two countries.
- 2. The agreement was signed in New Delhi.
- 3. With this Israel has become the 1st Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) member state to sign this strategic agreement under India's new model for investment treaty framework.

5th edition of Lok Samvardhan Parv concludes successfully in Kerala

- 1. The Ministry of Minority Affairs successfully concluded the 5th edition of Lok Samvardhan Parv at Marine Exhibition area in Kochi, Kerala.
- 2. This 10-day even took place under the framework of the Pradhan Mantri Virasat ka Samvardhan (PM-VIKAS).

DST to organize 1st ever **ESTIC**

- 1. Department of Science and Technology unveiled the theme for the Emerging Science, Technology and Innovation Conclave - 2025 (ESTIC 2025) at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi.
- 2. The theme of the event is **Viksit Bharat 2047 Pioneering Sustainable** Innovation, Technological Advancement and Empowerment'.

CCI approves acquistion of Dana Incorporated's off-highway business

The Competition Commission of India (CCI) has approved the proposed the acquisition of Dana Incorporated's off-highway business by Allison Transmission Holdings Inc. for approximately \$2.7 billion.

GoI extends Ajay Kumar's tenure as MD & CEO of IOB



1. The GoI has extended the tenure of Ajay Kumar Srivastava who is the MD & CEO of Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) till October 8, 2027 or until further orders whichever is earlier.

Jyotiraditya M.Scindia launches UPI-UPU integration

- 1. Ministry of Development of North eastern region minister Jyotiraditya Scindia launched the 'UPI-UPU integration project' in Dubai, UAE.
- 2. This integration will enable the users to facilitate the cross-border payments via post offices, offering enhanced speed and reduced costs.
- 3. This is developed by the Department of Posts and the Universal Postal Union (UPU)

IFC commits Rs.498cr to GVMC

- 1. International Finance Corporation (IFC) committed Rs.498cr to the Greater Vishakapatnam Municipal Coporation (GVMC) for the Development of the Madhurawada Sewerage System Project in Vishakapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.
- 2. The estimated cost of the project is Rs.533cr in which Rs.498cr via IFC and Rs.45.64cr through the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0 and Rs.9.36cr from GVMC.

NPCI grants TPAP approval to Viyona Fintech to offer UPI services

- 1. NPCI has granted Third Party Application Provider (TPAP) approval to Viyona Fintech to offer UPI services in colloboration with partner banks.
- 2. The approval covers Viyona's two applications GraamPay and Viyona Pay both of which can now facilitate UPI-based transactions.
