
World Teacher's Day 2025



- 1. World Teachers' Day (WTD), observed annually on October 5 by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO), celebrates and honours teachers for their crucial role in educating and shaping future generations.
- 2. The theme of the year is "Recasting teaching as a collaborative profession".
- 3. **It was first observed on October 5, 1994,** to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the 1966 conference.s

- 1. World Cerebral Palsy Day (WCPD) is annually observed across the globe on October 6 to raise awareness of Cerebral Palsy.
- 2. It began with a small campaign called "Change My World in One Minute", initiated by the Cerebral Palsy Alliance in Australia.
- 3. The theme of the day is "Unique and United".

NATIONAL AFFAIRS

Union Minister Amit Shah Inaugurates India's First Cooperative Multi-Feed CBG & Potash Granule Project in Maharashtra

- 1. Union Minister Amit Shah, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and Ministry of Cooperation, inaugurated India's first cooperative multi-feed Compressed Biogas (CBG) plant and Potash Granule production facility at the Maharshi Shankarrao Kolhe Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana Limited in Ahilyanagar, Maharashtra.
- 2. The move aligns with the initiative of Government of India such as "Waste to Wealth" and "Atmanirbhar Bharat".
- 3. Under NCDC, GOI will extend support to 15 selected sugar mills.

Govt Approved Mitigation, Recovery and Reconstruction Projects worth over Rs 4,600 Crore across 9 States

- 1. Union Minister Amit Shah, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), has approved the number of mitigation, recovery and reconstruction projects worth Rs 4645.60 crore for 9 states including Assam, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh (MP), Odisha, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh and Andhra Pradesh
- 2. The HLC has approved a plan for the restoration and rejuvenation of wetlands for Assam, with total budget outlay of Rs 692.05 crore.

- 3. The HLC has approved a total budget outlay of Rs 2,444.42 crore for Phase-II of UFRMP that will be funded from the NDMF.
- 4. The programme will be implemented in 11 cities.
- 5. The HLC has also approved a flood mitigation programme for Guwahati(Assam)with a total budget of Rs 200 crore, of which the centre government will contribute Rs 180 crore as its share from NDMF.
- 6. The HLC also approved financial assistance of Rs 1270.788 crore and Rs 260.56 crore to states of Assam and Kerala, respectively, for recovery and reconstruction activities/plan for the states due to flood/landslide incident of 2022 and Wayanad landslide-2024.

India-UK Bilateral Maritime Exercise 'KONKAN-2025' Commences Off India's Western Coast

- 1. The India Navy (IN) and the Royal Navy (RN) of the United Kingdom (UK), have initiated the bilateral maritime exercise 'KONKAN-2025' off India's western coast. The MoU is valid for an **initial period of three years.**
- 2. This year marks the first time India, and the UK have deployed their full Carrier Strike Groups (CSGs) for a joint maritime exercise.
- 3. The Exercise KONKAN-25, scheduled from October 5 to 12, 2025, is being conducted in two phases namely the Harbour Phase and the Sea Phase.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launches the nationwide 'Aapki Punji AapkAdhikar'campaign in Gujarat

- 1. Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched the nationwide 'Aapki Punji Aapka Adhikar' campaign from Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- 2. It aims to facilitate the speedy settlement of unclaimed financial assets lying across various sectors of the financial system.

APPOINTMENTS

Group Captain Shubansh Sukla Appointed Ambassador of Viksit Bharat Buildathon

- 1. Group Captain Shubansh Sukla, first Indian to reach the International Space Station (ISS), was appointed as the brand ambassador for the Viksit Bharat Buildathon.
- 2. It was the largest-ever school hackathon, engaging over 1 crore students from 1.5 lakh schools to create prototypes across four themes.

Shimon Sakaguchi, Mary E. Brunkow, Fred Ramsdell Win Nobel Prize



- 1. Shimon Sakaguchi, a Japanese Immunologist, Mary E. Brunkow, an American molecular biologist and immunologist, Fred Ramsdell, an American immunologist, are declared as the winners of Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine 2025 by the Nobel Assembly at Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm, Sweden.
- 2. These scientists received Nobel Prize for their discoveries concerning peripheral immune tolerance that prevents the immune system from harming the body.

Indian Peacemakers are awarded for dedicated service by UNISFA

1. Indian Peacemakers in Abeyi, Sudan were Honored for their dedication towards the service by Major General Robert Yaw Affram.

India Claims 8 Gold Medals at ISSF Junior World Cup 2025 i

- 1. India finishes at the top in the medal tally with a total of 26 medals, including 8 golds in the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) Junior World Cup Rifle/Pistol/Shotgun 2025, final stage, concluded in Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Range, New Delhi.
- 2. The event marked the 11th edition of the ISSF Junior World Cup, and the first ever hosted in India.
- 3. The previous edition was held in Suhl, Germany, from 19–27 May 2025. INDIAN GOLD WINNERS

India Hosts 12th World Para Athletics Championships 2025

- 1. The 12th edition of the World Para Athletics Championships (WPAC) 2025, held at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi, Delhi from 27th September to 5th October 2025.
- 2. India became the first country in South Asia to host the championship.
- **3.** The previous edition (11th) of the event in 2024 was held in Kobe, Japan.
- **4.** Brazil has topped the medal tally with a total of 44 medals (15 Gold, 20 Silver, and 9 Bronze), China positioned second place with 52 medals (13 Gold), and Iran as third with 15 medals (9 Gold).

5. India secured 22 medals, including 6 Gold, 9 Silver, and 7 Bronze medals, finishing 10th in the overall medal tally.
